COMMUNITY SURVEY HIGHLIGHTS

Town of Chesterfield

A. SURVEY OVERVIEW

As part of the public engagement component of the Town of Chesterfield Smart Growth Comprehensive Plan Update, an online community survey was developed. The purpose of this survey was to gather input from community members, residents, visitors, business owners, and other stakeholders about the Town of Chesterfield. This information will help inform the overall needs, vision, and priorities of the Town and help shape the Town's Smart Growth Comprehensive Plan.



The survey was created and distributed using the Survey Monkey web platform and went live on April 30th, 2024. Paper copies were made available at Chesterfield Town Hall on 1 Vine Street, Keeseville. Paper copies were submitted at Town Hall (1 Vine Street, Keeseville) by June 30th. The survey remained open until June 30th, 2024, with 324 responses received.

The survey was advertised on the project website (www.PlanChesterfield.com) and the Town of Chesterfield website (www.chesterfieldny.com). Additionally, several press releases were distributed prior to and during the survey period, as well as social media platform pushes from the Town and Committee Members. Information and links to the survey were also distributed during the survey period on cards and flyers throughout the Town, which included a Quick Response (QR) code so respondents could access the survey directly on a mobile device.

Data Limitations

The survey is one piece of many public engagement activities that help recognize themes throughout the community. Because the survey responses are self-selecting, they are not statistically valid. The survey alone cannot be used to find the "answer" or "solution", but it can in part help guide the community's long-term vision and identify the tools and actions needed to achieve that vision. Furthermore, creating state and local partnerships and strengthening opportunities to apply for funding from New York State sources to implement projects.

B. SURVEY TOPIC AREAS

The survey was divided into several topical areas to focus and categorize the questions. The survey topic areas include Demographic, Background information, & Values, Ideal Vision, Concerns, Opportunities, Land-Use, Recreation and Waterfront. Below is a description of each survey topic area.

Demographic, Background Information, & Values (Q1-Q8)

The demographic, background information, and values section focuses on who is taking the survey. Getting a broad range of responders from the local area is important to address the needs of different demographics. Knowing age, relation to the Town, housing demographics, and values can help address the communities needs and where to broadcast information. Furthermore, knowing the responses are representative of a variety of respondents can assist in making decisions that incorporate everyone.

Quality of Life (Q9-Q12)

The quality-of-life section focuses on how respondents feel about their quality-of-life, values, and their surroundings in the Town of Chesterfield. Understanding what makes the Town of Chesterfield unique and a place to call home helps identify which features of the Town can be enhanced to brighten the overall quality-of-life in the Town.


The Future (Q13-19)

The future section of the survey gauges what aspects of the community are utilized the most and what their ideal vision of the Town looks like. It is necessary to understand how community members interact with the Town and what concerns and priorities might arise that should be addressed in the Comprehensive Plan.

C. Survey Highlights

The following is a brief highlight of selected survey findings from each section of the survey.


Demographic, Background Information & Values (Q1 – Q8)



Question 1 (Q1) of the survey asked respondents to select which locality they most associate with their home and/or business. This question gives further insight into the respondent's relation to the Town. Out of the 323 respondents to this question, 39.94% associate with Keeseville and 19.50% associate with the Town of Chesterfield. Of the 8.67% that specified other, a majority of these respondents associate with Trembleau.


Question 2 (Q2) of the survey asked respondents to enter their zip code. The three most prevalent zip codes for respondents were:

- 12944
- 12975
- 12972




Question 3 (Q3) of the survey asked respondents to enter their age. The largest respondent age group was the 45-64-year-old age group (38.32%). Of the 321 respondents that answered this question, 30.84% were in the 65-79-year-old age group, 24.30% were in the 25-44- age group, 2.80% were in the 80+ age group, 2.49% were in the 18-24-year-old age group, and 1.25% were in the under 18 age group. According to the ACS 2022 5-year estimate, 25.5% of the 45-64-year-old, 20.9% of the 25-44-year-old age group, and 23.6% of the 65+ age group make up the largest cohorts in the Town of Chesterfield¹. This indicates that the age of the respondents who completed the survey closely represents the Town's population.




Question 4 (Q4) of the survey asked respondents to select the number of people in their household. The responses indicate that nearly half (46.73%) of the 321 respondents have a 2-person household.




Question 5 (Q5) of the survey asked respondents to select the number of people in their household under the age of 18. This question allows the Town to better understand the youth population growing up in the Town of Chesterfield. Subsequently, the responses indicate that 69.47% of the 321 respondents have no one in their household below the age of 18. 13.40% of people have two (2) people under 18 in their household and 12.15% have one (1) person under 18 in their household.



Question 6 (Q6) of the survey asked respondents to select all that apply to their relationship with the Town of Chesterfield. The majority of respondents (69.78%) own a primary home in the Town of Chesterfield. In the "other" category, respondents stated other connections to the Town of Chesterfield such as owning property, living nearby, or the Town of Chesterfield is their hometown.




Question 7 (Q7) of the survey asked respondents for how long they lived/worked/or vacationed in the Town of Chesterfield. Of the 323 respondents, more than half (59.75%) have lived/worked/vacationed in the Town for 20+ years.



Question 8 (Q8) of the survey asked respondents how they get news about the Town. This is informative for future project plans, identifying where to publish information to reach the widest audience. Out of 321 respondents, the majority receive news from social media (74.45%). In the "Other" category, the most common source was word of mouth.



Quality of Life (Q9 – Q12)



Question 9 (Q9) asked respondents to select three (3) of their top values regarding Town of Chesterfield. The graph above shows a breakdown of what respondents value the most. Out of the 298 responses, the highest ranked was "Access to Outdoor Recreation" (75.84%). Followed by a "Sense of Community/Neighborhood" (55.03%), "Access to Local Businesses" (46.31%), and "Support for Local Businesses" (36.58%). The least valued was "Access to Employment" (8.39%). Within the "Other" category, notable responses included peacefulness and safety. This is critical for planning future initiatives as the results provide insight into potential sectors for improvement within the Village.

Question 10 (Q10) was open-ended and asked respondents to share what they feel is an exceptionally important asset to the Town of Chesterfield. Of the 257 responses to this question, the most common themes were:

Lake Champlain and AuSable River/Chasm

• These areas were frequently mentioned as significant assets with references to their beauty, recreational opportunities, and importance to local tourism and community activities.

Historic Bridges

• The Town's historic bridges are mentioned often, reflecting their importance to the community's identity, heritage, and aesthetic appeal.


Local Businesses


 Many responses emphasize the importance of supporting local businesses including shops, restaurants, breweries, and farms, as key to the Town's economic vitality and community character.

Strong Sense of Community

Many noted the strong sense of community and people as a strong asset for the Town.

Question 11 (Q11) asked respondents to select their top three (3) recreational interests within the Town of Chesterfield. Of the 293 respondents, the most popular recreational interests in the Town are trail hiking (54.61%), swimming (37.88%), and boating/sailing (33.45%). In the "other" category, camping, snowshoeing, and farming were mentioned frequently as recreational interests.





Question 12 (Q12) asked respondents to select their top three (3) outdoor recreational resources that they utilize the most. Of the 296 respondents to this question, Lake Champlain is the most utilized recreational resource (62.16%). Port Kent Beach (34.80%) and Port Douglass Beach and Picnic Area (34.46%) are both utilized equally.

The Future (Q13 – Q19)

Ideal Vision Question 13 (Q13) was open-ended and asked respondents to describe their ideal vision of the Town in 5 to 10 years from now. There were 241 total comments received. The breakdown of the common themes from the responses are found below.

Revitalization and Economic Development:

- Thriving Downtown area with a variety of small businesses, shops, restaurants, and grocery stores.
- Promotion of businesses to enhance tourism and attract visitors.
- Development and utilization of industrial parks and commercial spaces.
- Preservation and enhancement of historic and cultural assets to foster a vibrant community.

Community and Family-Oriented Environment:

- Safe, clean, and quiet neighborhoods.
- Strong sense of community with frequent community events, gatherings, and activities.
- Family-friendly amenities and spaces, including parks, playgrounds, and recreational centers.

Improved Infrastructure and Accessibility:


- Well-maintained streets, bridges, and sidewalks.
- Expanded and improved trail systems for hiking and walking.
- Enhanced public amenities.

Housing and Residential Development:

- Availability of quality, affordable housing for all income levels.
- Restoration and upkeep of existing residential properties.
- New housing developments that respect the rural charm and agricultural heritage of the area.

Tourism and Recreation:

- Capitalizing on natural assets like Lake Champlain for recreational opportunities.
- Development of beach amenities, marinas, and waterfront attractions.
- Increased outdoor recreation options, including hiking, boating, and agritourism activities.



Challenges/Concerns Question 14 (Q14) asked respondents to identify three (3) of their top challenges/concerns for the Town now and in the future. Of the 262 respondents, availability of local shopping, restaurants, and amenities (46.18%) and run-down, vacant, and abandoned properties (46.18%) were equally the top concerns for respondents. Property taxes (36.64%) and housing affordability (27.86%) were also identified as being significant challenges/concerns for the Town. Other challenges and concerns noted were community cleanliness, public safety, and zoning and property maintenance.

Opportunities/Priorities Question 15 (Q15) was open-ended and asked respondents to describe their top three (3) priorities for the Town of Chesterfield to focus on for the future improvement of the Town. Based on the 235 respondents, the overarching common themes from the responses are downtown revitalization and economic growth, infrastructure improvements, housing and community development, recreation, and public safety. Common responses from each theme are as follows:

Downtown Revitalization and Economic Growth

- Revitalizing downtown areas, restoring historic buildings, and attracting businesses.
- Advertising and promoting the Town of Chesterfield to attract more visitors and residents.
- Supporting local businesses and creating a thriving, attractive main street.

Infrastructure Improvements

- Enhancing water and sewer infrastructure to ensure reliability and quality.
- Improving roads, sidewalks, and overall public safety.
- Addressing rundown properties and enforcing zoning regulations

Housing and Community Development

- Providing affordable housing options
- Incentivizing new housing developments, especially for younger generations and families.
- Maintaining and creating safe, well-designed residential neighborhoods.


Recreation

- Expanding outdoor recreation opportunities
- Improving existing recreational facilities and developing new ones.
- Promoting community events and activities to enhance quality of life for residents.


Public Safety

- Cleaning up and revitalizing problematic areas
- Supporting community organizations and initiatives that foster a strong sense of community

Opportunities/Priorities Question 16 (Q16) asked respondents to rate the following questions, using a scale of "Strongly Agree" to "Strongly Disagree". Of the 263 responses, "Protection of natural resources and wildlife habitat" (69.96%, Strongly Agree), "Expansion of recreational amenities and opportunities" (54.02%, Strongly Agree), and "Expansion of economic opportunities" (50.57%, Strongly Agree), had the highest frequency of voters. This suggests respondents are interested in sustainable development that balances economic growth with environmental protection. This should be considered when approaching all opportunities for growth in the Town of Chesterfield.



Housing Question 17 (Q17) asked respondents to select what types of housing should be prioritized in the Town of Chesterfield over the next 10 years. Of the 263 responses, 55.51% chose single-family housing, 55.13% chose a mix of housing types for a variety of income levels, and 43.35% chose senior/assisted housing.



Future Growth Question 18 (Q18) asked respondents to select what type of future growth they would like to see in the Town of Chesterfield over the next 20 years. Of the 258 responses, 50.39% would like

to see sustainable development, 37.21% farming industry, and 35.66% industrial/light manufacturing development.

Question 19 (Q19) asked respondents to share any other comments or ideas for the Town of Chesterfield. Below is an overview of the key themes mentioned:

Infrastructure and Maintenance

- Maintain and repair existing infrastructure, including historic bridges, roads, and public spaces
- Enhance and clean up public areas
- Address safety concerns with specific infrastructure improvements

Community and Economic Development

- Encourage the development of local businesses, including grocery stores, restaurants, and lodging options
- Revitalize downtown areas, attract new businesses, and utilize town assets to stimulate economic growth
- Balance small-town charm with smart economic growth that improves and complements the community

Recreation and Tourism

- Invest in recreational facilities and activities
- Promote tourism by leveraging natural beauty, historic sites, and creating vibrant main streets
- Develop cultural and entertainment options

Community Engagement and Support

- Foster a sense of community through events
- Support community organizations and initiatives

Housing and Affordability

- Address housing affordability by considering alternative housing options
- Develop and maintain affordable housing to retain and attract residents
- Ensure zoning and regulations support diverse and affordable housing solutions while preserving the Town's character and charm

Q5 Please select the number of people in your household under the age of 18:





The reason that farmers are granted some tax breaks is the same reason that there aren't very many farmers anymore - farmers make barely enough to keep at it, truly. The Farm Bill creates a complicated web of subsidies - but none of them go to the small farmer. That is why things like agritourism come in to play. If we could make enough money to pay our bills doing the work we chose to do as farmers without having to do all these other little hustles - farm stays and added value work and so on - we certainly would just do that. Support the small farmers, support agritourism, understand their economics up close, and leave the agricultural districts in tact for the coming generations who may not be able to subsist on food from California the way most of us do today! Every generation of small agriculture looks different. Small, alternative housing options like tiny homes and cabins make a huge difference in retaining our population of 20-30 year olds.
